Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 White and green watercolor panel
- 1 White heart die cut panel
- 1 Sentiment strip
- 1 Green panel
- 1 Foam panel- adhesive backed
- 1 Foam strip- adhesive backed
- 1 Mailing liner
- (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the watercolor panel, the heart die cut panel, the sentiment strip, the foam strip and the foam panel.

1. Layer the watercolor panel behind the heart die cut panel. Shift and arrange it so that the color shows in the way you prefer. This might mean the panel is sideways or angled. As long as the panel sits behind all open areas, there is no wrong answer! Once decided, glue the watercolor panel behind the die cut heart panel and trim any excess that goes beyond the heart die cut panel.
2. Next, adhere the foam panel to the back of the layered heart panel.
3. Now adhere the card front panel you created to the front of the white card base. Make sure to leave an even border along the top and bottom. See example picture for placement ideas.
4. To finish the front of the card, adhere the foam strip to the back of the sentiment strip. Then add that to the card front. See example picture for placement ideas.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Adhere the green panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
