# Kit B

## **Let's Make Beautiful Things Together**

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



#### Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

#### Contents:

1 White card base

1 White stamped panel

1 White Hello die cut backer

1 Mustard Hello die cut

1 Black Friend die cut

3 White die cut leaf stems

1 Mustard panel (textured on one side)

1 Set of foam pieces- adhesive backed

1 Mailing liner

(mailing liner only needed if you

mail your card)\*\*

1 Coordinating envelope\*



## Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the stamped panel, the 2 Hello die cut pieces, the Friend die cut and the foam squares.

- 1. Adhere the white stamped panel to the front of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
- 2. Next, adhere the Mustard Hello die cut to the white die cut backer. Align it to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
- 3. Add the foam pieces to the back of the layered Hello die cut. The long piece should fit along the middle. The 2 smaller squares are for you to place as needed.
- 4. Adhere the Hello to the card front.
- 5. Adhere the Friend die cut over the Hello die cut. -Don't forget the dot to the i! TIP: Use small dots of liquid glue on the back of the Friend and gently press the glue side to a scratch paper to remove excess glue before adding it to the card front.

### That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of our card.

- 1. The Mustard is a textured paper. I chose to use the back to make it easier to write a message. You should use whichever side you prefer!
- 2.Adhere the white stem die cuts to decorate the bottom of the mustard panel. Trim any excess and use those trimmed pieces to fill in space as you like. Have fun with this part!
- 3. Finally, adhere the decorated Mustard panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
