Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

 White card base
Green panel
Peach panel
Sending Smiles die cut with heart
Leaf die cut set (includes solid backer and detail front to 12 leaves)
Sequins set
Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the green panel, the leaf die cuts, the sending smiles set and the sequins.

- 1. Let's begin by adhering the leaf die cuts together. Each leaf has 2 parts. Adhere the front leaf detail die cut to the solid leaf backer. Use the example picture to determine which direction the leaf will go. If you plan to arrange your leaves in a different pattern than the example, this is the time to decide which direction you want them to go.
- 2. Next, adhere the Sending Smiles die cut to the green panel. Make sure to leave room for your leaf arrangement. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 3. Now you will add the leaf die cuts. For a good idea of where they will go, place them on the panel without glue, first. This will help you with the right spacing and arrangement. Decide which leaves will overlap the others and how they will hang off the edge.
- 4. Adhere the leaf die cuts, one at a time. You will need to use a strong liquid craft glue for this. Trim any excess after each leaf so you don't build up too many layers to cut. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 5. To finish the front of the card, use small dots of liquid glue to adhere the sequins for decoration. See example picture for placement ideas. (this step is optional)
- 6. Adhere the decorated card front to the white card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Adhere the peach panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
