Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 White frame
- 1 White panel - embossed
- 1 Girl with Gifts die cut set (boots with toes and cuffs, tights with stripes, jacket with buttons, arm piece with mittens, 6 gifts and 1 bow)
- 2 White hillside pieces (1 large, 1 small)
- 1 Raspberry panel, stamped
- Sequins
- Foam strips
- 1 Coordinating envelope*
- 1 Mailing Liner** (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the white embossed panel, the Girl with Gifts die set, the hillsides, the sequins, the frame and the foam strips.

1. Adhere the large hillside piece to the bottom of the embossed panel. It will align along the bottom edge but will hang off of each end. Trim any excess. Next, repeat that step with the smaller hillside. Trim any excess.
2. Now, let's build the girl and her gifts! To start, use small dots of liquid glue to adhere the 2 boot toe pieces to the boots. The straighter edge of the toe piece sits towards the inside, creating a left and right foot. Next, add the cuff piece to the top of each boot.
3. To create the stripes of the leggings, add small dots of liquid glue to each indented stripe on the legging. Carefully add each light pink stripe to the glue
4. Use small dots of liquid glue to adhere the 2 buttons to the front of the jacket. See example picture for placement ideas.
5. To construct the large gift and mitten piece, adhere the largest gift to the top portion of the arm piece. This will leave some of the arm piece showing below the gift. Adhere the 2 mitten pieces over the front edge of the gift. See example picture for placement.
6. Adhere the constructed gift/mitten piece to the top portion of the jacket.
7. Before adding the other gifts, adhere the constructed girl to the embossed panel. Use the frame for placement help. Her feet should sit on the hillsides and she should stand centered in the frame reaching to around the halfway height. Once you've decided the position, adhere her in place.
8. Now adhere the rest of the gifts to the embossed panel. See example picture for placement ideas. Continue to use the frame piece for spacing reference if needed.
9. Use the foam strips to adhere the frame to the decorated embossed panel. One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side.
10. Now that the card front is constructed, adhere it to the front of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
11. Finally, use small dots of liquid glue to adhere the sequins to the embossed panel for added decoration. See example picture for placement ideas.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Adhere the stamped raspberry panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
