Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

1 White card base

1 White embossed panel

1 Merry Christmas die cut

1 Christmas Girl die cut

1 Gifts die cut

3 Heart embellishments

l Green panel

1 White panel

1 Mailing liner

(mailing liner only needed if you

mail your card)**

1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the embossed panel, the Girl die cut, the Merry Christmas die cut and the heart embellishments.

- 1. Begin by decorating the white embossed panel. I recommend using a liquid adhesive because of the uneven surface. Adhere the Merry Christmas to the bottom of the embossed panel. Do not add glue behind the M, S, and R. The Girl die cut will sit over the I, but behind the M, S, and R letters. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 2. Next, adhere the Christmas Girl die cut to the embossed panel. Decide your placement first to see where you like it. Then glue it in place.
- 3. Using small dots of liquid glue, add the heart embellishments to the embossed panel.
- 4. Now that your card front is finished, adhere it to the card base using a strong double sided tape or liquid craft glue.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

- 1. Adhere the remaining white panel to the green panel making sure to leave an even border of green showing along each edge.
- 2. Add the Gifts die cut to the layered panel for decoration.
- 3. Now adhere the layered green and white panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
