

# Kit B

## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 Navy card base
- 1 Navy splattered panel
- 2 Cloud die cuts (1 darker blue, 1 light)
- 3 White hillside pieces (1 for the inside of the card)
- 1 Truck and Goodies die cut set (1 truck, 2 wheel wells, 2 gray bumpers, 1 doorknob, 2 \*3-piece wheel sets, 4 wood pieces, 1 tree with garland and ornaments, 2 \*5-piece gift sets)
- 1 Light blue panel
- 1 Foam panel (adhesive backed)
- 1 Coordinating envelope\*
- 1 Mailing Liner\*\* (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)



Let's Begin! We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the splattered panel, the 2 blue cloud pieces, the white hillside pieces, and the truck and goodies die cut set.

1. Let's put the background scene together first. The order of placement will be the darker cloud first, next the lighter cloud, then 1 hillside piece, then the second hillside piece. Decide where the clouds and hillsides will sit. You will only use 2 of the white hillsides. The 3rd hillside will go on the inside of the card. Use whichever 2 you prefer. Arrange the clouds higher, or lower, depending on your preference. Then decide where the hillsides will sit. TIP: Use the truck die cut to help with placement. I encourage you to place the truck where the cloud lines show through the window. This can add interest to the scene.
2. Once you've determined placement, adhere the background scene pieces in place, one at a time. TRIM any excess before adding another layer. This allows for easier trimming. If you plan to tuck the wheels behind the front hillside piece, make sure to leave that area free of glue.
3. Now that the background scene is done, let's build the truck. I recommend using tweezers or a jewel picker tool when working with such small pieces. To start, adhere the 2 gray bumper pieces to the front and back of the truck. They are similar in shape, but still different. Then add the gray doorknob by first adding glue to the indented doorknob spot. Then set the gray doorknob onto the glue spot. See example picture for placement help.
4. Next, add the red wheel well pieces to the front and rear wheels. See example picture for placement help.
5. Now construct the 2 wheels and glue them to the truck. The wheels will have even spacing with the gray circle on the white circle and the white circle on the black.
6. Next, construct the wood railing. Add small dots of glue onto the short railing pieces. Set the long railing pieces onto the glue spots so that the hole on each end is lined up. See example picture for placement ideas.
7. After the railing has dried, adhere it to the top edge of the truck bed. Add a small amount of glue to the back of the top edge of the truck bed and press the bottom edge of the railing into it. Hold it in place until it dries. See example picture for placement ideas.
8. Now it's time to adhere the truck to the background scene. There is a piece of double sided tape on the back of the truck to keep the thin detail elements in place. You can use this by removing the release paper and also add liquid glue as needed. Do not add glue behind the railing. You need this to stay open. Don't forget to tuck the wheels behind the snow a little, if you like it that way.
9. To decorate the tree, use the white garland in small sections across the tree. Trim as needed. Then add the ornaments. I did not add decorations at the bottom of the tree because that area will be covered up.
10. You have 2 gift die cuts to create. One gift will go in the truck, the other is to decorate the inside of the card. To construct the gift, adhere the white scallop piece to the top of the plaid box. Then create the bow separately by adhering the small

bow piece onto the larger bow piece. Finally add the heart topped stem to the center of the bow connection. Adhere the bow to the gift by adding glue to the back of the stem and leaving the bow section open. See example picture for placement ideas.

11. Once the tree and gift have been created, adhere them into place behind the railing.

12. To finish the card front add the foam panel behind the constructed card front and adhere it to the card base making sure to leave an even border of navy showing along each edge.

**That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.**

1. Adhere the remaining white hillside to the light blue panel. Trim any excess.

2. Add the 2nd constructed gift die cut to the panel for decoration.

3. Finally, adhere the decorated panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of navy showing along each edge.
