Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 White backer panel
- 7 Rainbow paper strips
- 7 Rainbow sentiment strips
- 1 White frame embossed panel
- 1 Light blue embossed panel
- Foam squares, foam strips
- 1 Mailing liners (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the white backer panel, the paper strips, the sentiment strips, the white frame embossed panel and the foam pieces.

1. Let's create the striped background panel first. See example picture for placement ideas. Carefully align the top paper strip along the top edge of the white backer piece. Once it is straight, the other stripes should all line up straight. The paper strips will overhang at the ends. This will be trimmed later.
2. Continue creating the striped background by adhering each strip into place. Once the panel is dry, turn the panel over and trim the excess.
3. Now, adhere the striped background panel to the front of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
4. Next, determine the placement of the sentiment strips. Lay them on the white frame panel to see where you want them. Once the placement has been decided, adhere them one at a time using the thin foam strips. These have adhesive on each side.
5. Finally, use the foam panel to adhere the decorated white frame piece to the striped background piece. *One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side. Make sure to leave an even border of the striped background piece showing along each edge.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of our card.

1. Adhere the light blue frame embossed panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

And you did it!
