#### Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive <sup>(2)</sup> But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

#### Contents:

 White card base
White panel with leaves
Navy sentiment
Set of flower die cuts (2 petal pieces, 1 navy center, 1 golden flourish,
2 large leaves, 1 small leaf)
1 Green panel
Foam squares
Foam panel
1 Mailing liner
(mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)\*\*
1 Coordinating envelope\*



### Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the leaf panel, the flower die cuts, the sentiment and the foam squares.

- 1. To create the flower, offset the two white petal pieces and adhere them together. Next, adhere the navy center to the middle of the flower.
- 2. Now create the golden flourish piece. This fringe die cut will create a dimensional center for the flower. Use your fingers, or the tip of something sharp, and begin rolling the fringe piece into a tight roll. Work with the uncut edge and roll from one end to the other. Add a small dot of glue to the end corner and adhere it in place so it won't come unrolled.
- 3. Use liquid glue to adhere the base of the rolled flourish to the center of the flower. Hold in place until the glue sets. To flatten the flourish, squish the fringe down with your finger and spread the pieces out a little until you like it.
- 4. Now, arrange the flower and leaves on the white leaf panel until you like the placement. Keep in mind that you want the elements to be able to fit into an envelope. I allowed mine to hang off the edge, but only a little. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 5. Adhere the leaves to the back of the flower and then adhere the constructed flower embellishment to the white leaf panel with the large foam square \*One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side. Add any additional glue as needed.
- 6. Next, adhere the sentiment to the card front. I've included a foam strip for you to use as needed to help keep it level.
- 7. Finally, use the foam panel to adhere the constructed card front to the front of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge. \*One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side. For this card, I recommend a strong double sided tape, if you have any.

## Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

1. Adhere the green panel to the inside of your card base, making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

And you did it!
