# Kit A

## **Let's Make Beautiful Things Together**

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ③ But you can always just use what you have!



#### Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

#### Contents:

1 Black card base
1 Fully stamped panel
1 Half stamped panel (for inside of the card)
1 Sentiment
1 Typewriter
1 Set of flower die cuts (3 white flowers, 2 leaves, 2 flower centers, 1 orange flower, 2 leaf stems)
Foam square- adhesive backed
1 Mailing liner
(mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)\*\*
1 Coordinating envelope\*



# Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the fully stamped panel, the sentiment, the typewriter, the flower set and the foam square.

- 1. Construct the flowers by adhering the flower centers to the white flowers. The largest flower needs the orange center. The medium flower needs the peach center. The tulip flower is accented with the small orange tulip. See example pictures for placement ideas.
- 2. Now decide the placement of the flowers and leaves. See example picture for placement ideas. Reminder: the largest flower and leaves will be reserved for the inside of the card.
- 3. I found this way the easiest to put the flowers and typewriter together. Use a double sided tape or liquid glue to adhere the foam square to the back of the typewriter. Reserve the adhesive backed side of the foam for the next step.
- 4. Remove the release paper from the back of the foam square. You can now add the flowers and leaf stems, using the foam's adhesive to keep them in place. TIP: I also used liquid glue to allow some adjustment time with my elements.
- 5. Adhere the typewriter and flower set pieces to the stamped panel using the adhesive from the back of the foam square and any additional adhesive that is needed. Adjust the pieces until you're happy with the arrangement. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 6. Next, adhere the decorated card front to the card base making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge.
- 7. Lastly, adhere the sentiment to the card front. See example picture for placement ideas.

### Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

- 1. Adhere the half stamped panel to the inside of your card base, making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge.
- 2. Add the remaining flower and leaves to the panel for added decoration. See example picture for placement ideas.
