## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ☺ But you can always just use what you have!



### Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

### Contents:

- 1 Black card base
- 1 Colored foil panel
- 5 Fringe pieces
- 1 Black frame
- 1 Blue frame
- 1 Die cut set (piñata, sentiment, candies)
- 1 Black string
- 1 White panel-plain
- 1 Blue panel-stamped
- Sequins
- Foam strips-adhesive on both sides
- Foam squares- adhesive backed (1 large, 1 small)
- 1 Mailing liner  
(mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)\*\*
- 1 Coordinating envelope\*



## Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the foil panel, the fringe pieces, the frame pieces, the die cut set, the string, the sequins and the foam pieces.

1. First, you will create the frame so it can help you with measurements. Adhere the black frame onto the blue frame making sure to line up the edges. Now add the foam strips behind the frame for dimension. Leave the release paper on the foam so that you can work with it without it being sticky.
2. Next, adhere the fringe pieces to the foil panel. Start with the bottom piece and layer them over each other. At this step, use the frame to help you see where to begin the fringe pieces. You'll want to ensure that the bottom fringe piece is placed higher than the bottom of the frame. This way you'll be able to see the fringe lift.
3. To fluff the fringe, use your finger or a tool (palette knife, pen, etc.) to gently raise random sections of the fringe. Do as much or as little as you like.
4. Now, use double sided tape to adhere one end of the string to the back of the piñata. Next, add the larger foam square to the back of the piñata. \*One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side. Adhere the piñata to the decorated panel with the string hanging free. See example picture for placement ideas.
5. Use double sided tape to adhere the remaining end of the string to the back of the foil panel. For added interest, allow room to add bends in the string and use small dots of liquid glue to tack down the string as needed.
6. Now it's time to add the frame. Remove the foam release paper and adhere the frame over the decorated panel in the position you prefer. If this creates overhang from the decorated panel, trim any excess.
7. Add the sentiment to the card front. The small remaining foam square is used to keep one end lifted while the other sits on the frame.
8. Lastly, use small dots of liquid glue to decorate the fringe with candy die cuts and sequins. See example picture for placement ideas.
9. Adhere the decorated panel to the front of the card base making sure to align each edge.

## **Now let's decorate the inside of our card!**

1. Adhere the blue panel to the white panel making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
2. Now adhere the white and blue layered panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge.
