Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

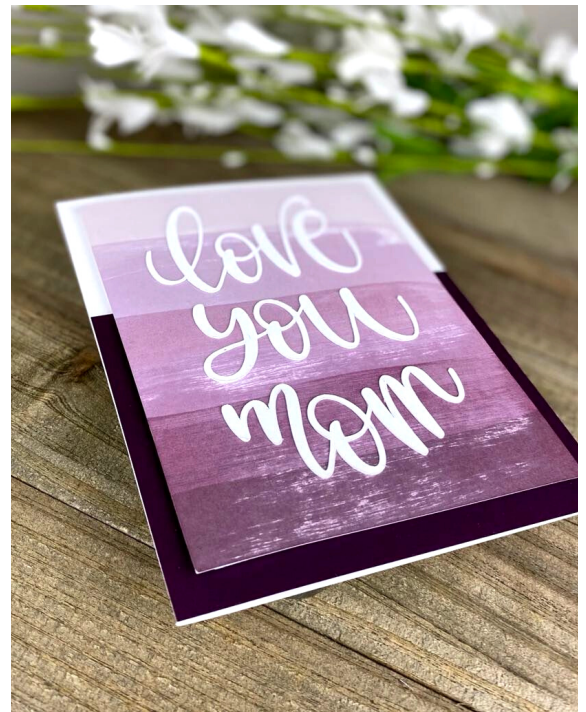
Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 Striped panel
- 1 Half striped panel(for inside the card)
- 1 Solid purple panel(for inside the card)
- 1 Solid purple half-panel
- 1 Whit panel
- 1 Love You Mom die cut set
- 1 Foam panel- adhesive backed
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need striped panel, the half purple panel, the Love You Mom words, the white panel and the foam panel.

1. Begin by deciding the placement of the word die cuts. Arrange them on the striped panel. Keeping them in place, pick up one section at a time and use a light application of liquid glue to adhere them to the striped panel. See example picture for placement ideas.
2. Next, adhere the solid purple half-panel to the white panel. Align them along the sides and bottom edge.
3. Add the foam panel to the back of the striped panel and then adhere that to the layered white panel. Make sure to leave an even border showing along the edge. *One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side.
4. Now, adhere the fully decorated panel to the front of the card base. It should align along each edge. TIP: Use a liquid glue to allow adjustments as needed.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of our card.

1. Adhere the half striped panel to the solid purple panel making sure to leave an even border of purple showing along each edge.
2. Lastly, adhere that layered piece to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

And you did it!
