Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive 😊 But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 White scallop panel
- 5 Rainbow stripes
- 16 Butterflies (2 of each rainbow color, 5 white, 1 holograph)
- 1 Hello die cut
- 4 Cloud pieces (2 large, 2 small)
- 1 Blue panel
- Foam strip- adhesive backed
- 1 Mailing liner (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the white scallop panel, the rainbow stripes, the butterflies, the hello die cut, the largest cloud piece and the foam strip.

1. Begin by creating your rainbow on the scallop panel. They should fit snugly together and will hang off the edge. Decide your placement and adhere them in place. Take care to not allow space between the stripes. Once they are adhered, trim any excess. NOTE: You will be creating a flat edge next to the scallop edge. See example picture.
2. Next, use the foam strip to adhere the largest cloud piece to the scallop panel. Trim any excess. See example picture for placement ideas. *One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side.
3. Adhere the Hello sentiment to the scallop panel. See example picture for placement ideas.
4. Now, adhere the butterflies for decoration. I slightly folded mine in half to allow the wings to pop up a little and I allowed my butterflies to hang off the edge a little for added interest. NOTE: The white butterflies have 2 sizes. See example picture for placement ideas.
5. Finally, adhere the decorated scallop panel to the front of the card base leaving an even border of white showing along each edge.

Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

1. Adhere the remaining cloud pieces to the blue panel. Trim any excess. See example picture for placement ideas.
2. Now adhere the decorated blue panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.



And you did it!
