Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ② But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

1 Black card base

1 Black panel

1 Kraft panel

1 White panel

7 Flower die cuts (7 tops, 7 stems)

1 White sentiment die cut

1 Black sentiment backer

2 Stamped sentiments (choose your favorite)

2 Foam pieces- adhesive backed

(1 large, 1 small)

1 Mailing liner

(mailing liner only needed if you

mail your card)**

1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the black panel, the flower die cuts, the die cut sentiment and backer, the stamped sentiment of your choice and the foam squares.

- 1. First, adhere the white die cut sentiment to the black backer leaving an even border showing along each edge. I recommend small dots of liquid glue for this. (If the glue gets too heavy, press it on to some scratch paper to remove some glue before adhering to the backer)
- 2. Next you will create the floral panel. In my example I decorated this panel with 6 flowers. But, I have included 7 flowers in your kit so that you have flexibility with your design. Arrange the flower die cuts on the black panel so that it creates a nice background for your sentiment. Use your sentiment to help with placement. See example picture for placement ideas. TIP: allow the flowers to hang off the edge to create interest, then trim any excess. ALSO, when adhering the flowers, I suggest setting them in place and adhere the flower top first. Then adhere the stem so that it lines up with the top.
- 3. Adhere the decorated floral panel to the front of the card base leaving an even border of black showing along each edge.
- 4. Now, use the large foam square to adhere the layered die cut sentiment to the front of your card. Leave room at the bottom for the smaller sentiment. See example picture for placement ideas. *One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side.
- 5. Finally, use the small foam strip to adhere the stamped sentiment to the front of your card. I have included to sentiments to make this card even more versatile. See example picture for placement ideas. *One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side.

Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

- 1. Adhere the white panel to the kraft panel making sure to leave an even border of kraft showing along each edge.
- 2. Now adhere the white and kraft layered panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge.



And you did it!
