Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 Embossed white/purple panel
- 1 White panel, plain
- 1 White and purple panel-inside of card
- 1 Wish I could hug you die cut (including the dot for the i)
- 1 Black stamped sentiment
- 1 Black heart
- 1 Foam panel (adhesive backed)
- 1 Mailing liner (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need all elements except the white and purple inside panel.

1. Begin by choosing a general placement for the card front elements.
2. Now, using liquid glue, adhere the "Wish I could hug you" die cut to the embossed panel. Take care to leave room for the stamped sentiment and the heart. TIP: Spread glue on a scrap paper and tap the back of the die cut into it to avoid excess glue.
3. Next adhere the Sending Love sentiment and the black heart to the decorated panel. See example picture for placement ideas.
4. Adhere the plain white panel to the front of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
5. Finally, adhere the foam panel to the back of the decorated embossed panel and then add it to the front of the card. One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side. There should be an even border of white showing along each edge.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Adhere the remaining white and purple panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

And you did it!
