Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ☺ But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 Navy card base
- 2 White panels
- 3 Blue flowers
- 2 Love die cuts- 1 navy, 1 gold
- 1 Set of gold embellishments
- 1 Set foam adhesive strips
- 1 Mailing liner
- (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need all elements except one of the white panels.

1. To begin, decorate one white panel with the 3 blue flowers. Arrange them to hang off the edge for added interest. You will adhere the flowers to the white panel using pieces of foam adhesive for dimension. Trim the foam to whatever size is needed. *One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side. Once a flower is adhered in place, trim the excess and consider using the trimmed pieces to add to your panel. Fill in any open spaces with trimmed pieces. See example picture for placement ideas. (any unused flower trimmings can be added to the inside of the card)
2. Next, use a light application of glue to adhere the gold Love die cut behind the navy Love die cut. Offset the words a little to see each color clearly. See example picture.
3. Adhere the layered Love sentiment to the decorated card front panel. For even more dimension, I cut thin strips of foam to adhere the Love sentiment to the panel. This step is optional.
4. Use small dots of liquid glue to adhere the gold embellishments to the panel. See example picture for placement ideas. I use a jewel picker tool to work with these embellishments. You could also use tweezers. I recommend adding the glue to the specific spot on the panel and setting the embellishment into the glue. 5. Finally, adhere the decorated card front panel to the front of the card base making sure to leave an even border of navy showing along each edge.



Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

1. Use remaining flower trimmings to decorate the remaining white panel. Trim any edges.
2. Once decorated, adhere the remaining white panel to the inside of your card base, making sure to leave an even border of navy showing along each edge.

And you did it!
