Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 Navy card base
- 1 Navy stamped panel
- 3 Kraft brown hillsides
- 4 Gold hillsides
- 1 Navy hillside- stamped
- 2 Stars (1 gold, 1 white)
- 2 Village die cuts (1 lg, 1 sm)
- 2 Mary/Joseph silhouettes\
- 1 Kraft brown panel (inside of card)
- 1 White hillside (inside of card)
- 2 Foam squares
- 1 Mailing liner
(mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the navy stamped panel, the brown and gold hillsides, the navy hillside, the gold star, the 2 village die cuts, the 2 silhouettes and the foam squares.

1. Let's begin by decorating the navy stamped panel. Your scene will be adhered to the lower portion of this panel allowing the words at the top to show.
2. Adhere the coordinating gold hillside to the back of each brown and navy hillside allowing a small border of gold to show over the top. See example picture.
3. Once the hillsides are together they will fit together like a puzzle. Begin by aligning the bottom edge of the navy hillside to the bottom of the navy panel. Adhere each layered hillside in place working toward the top of the panel. When adhering the middle two hillsides don't add glue to the very top edge to allow for the villages.
4. Using a small application of glue, tuck the villages in behind the hillsides. See example picture for placement ideas.
5. Adhere the gold star to the decorated panel.
6. Using the foam squares toward the top of the silhouettes, adhere the Mary/Joseph onto the decorated panel.
7. Finally, adhere the decorated panel to the front of the card base aligning it along each edge.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Adhere the remaining white hillside to the kraft brown panel. Trim any excess.
2. Add the white star for decoration.
3. Adhere the decorated kraft panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of navy showing along each edge.



And you did it!
