Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 Black card base
- 1 Red velvet panel
- 2 Sets of Christmas die cuts (1 white, 1 glitter)
- 1 Stamped black sentiment strip
- 4 Glitter corner accents
- 3 Holly sets (each has 2 leaves and 1 berry)
- 1 Red panel
- 1 White panel
- 1 Green stem die cut
- 1 Foam panel-adhesive backed
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the velvet panel, the Christmas letters, the stamped sentiment, the corner accents, the holly sets and the foam panel.

1. The velvet paper will require a liquid craft glue for adhesive. Some of the letters are small so I recommend a fine tip applicator for your glue OR squeeze some out on scratch paper and use a toothpick to help apply glue to the narrow spots.
2. Let's begin by decorating the velvet panel. The Christmas word has been pressed into the velvet panel to help you with the placement of your letters. Using a liquid craft glue, adhere the regular white Christmas letters in place. The glitter set will be used next. I encourage you to take your time and use a light application of glue. I've included a small glue swab to help clean up any glue that squishes out. The glue will dry clear but will leave the velvet paper marred. Take your time and have fun!
3. Once the white letters are in place, use a light application of glue to adhere the glitter letters over top of the white ones. This gives a more dimensional look to the letters.
4. Next, adhere the 4 corner accents to each corner of the velvet panel. See example picture.
5. Adhere the stamped sentiment in place. See example picture for placement ideas.
6. Finish decorating your panel with the holly leaf sets. Adhere 1 leaf in place. Next adhere the second leaf's corner over the first. Finally, adhere the berry over the join.
7. Adhere the foam panel to the back of the velvet panel and then adhere it to the front of the card base making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge. *One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Adhere the white panel to the red panel leaving an even border of red showing along each edge.
2. Adhere the green stem die cut to the layered panel for decoration. See example picture for placement ideas. Trim any excess
3. Add the decorated panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge.



And you did it!
