Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

Light blue card base
Large white panels
Smaller white panel
White rectangle
Stamped sentiment
Thanks die cut
Light blue flowers with dark blue centers (3 small, 3 large)
Dark blue flowers with light blue centers (1 small, 1 large)
Tan flower stems
Foam square- adhesive backed
Foam panel-adhesive backed
Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need all elements except the 1 large white panel and 1 Smaller white panel.

- 1. To begin, decorate 1 large white panel with the flower stems and flowers. Adhere the 3 tan stems on the large white panel evenly spaced. The top flower of the left and right stem should sit at the top of the panel. The center stem should hang off the panel at the top and bottom, leaving only 2 flowers showing. See example picture.
- 2. Once the stems are added, adhere the light and dark blue flowers to each stem, alternating sizes. See example picture for placement ideas. Trim any excess.
- 3. Adhere the flower centers.
- 4. Once the card front panel has been constructed, use the foam panel to adhere it to the front of the card base. *One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side.
- 5. To finish, use a light application of glue to adhere the Thanks die cut to the white rectangle and add it to the card with the foam square.
- 6. Finish the card front by adding the stamped sentiment. See example picture for placement ideas.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. The simple decoration for the inside of your card will be the remaining white panels. Layer the smaller one onto the larger one leaving an even border. Then adhere them to the inside of the card base.

And you did it!
