Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

1 Navy card base

1 Navy velvet panel

1 Navy splatter panel

1 White panel

1 Brighter Days die cut sentiment

3 Treeline die cuts

1 Moon die cut

1 Foam panel

1 Mailing liner

(mailing liner only needed if you

mail your card)**

1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!
We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the velvet panel, 2 Treeline die cuts, the moon die cut, the Brighter Days sentiment and the foam panel.

- 1. To begin, adhere 1 of the Treeline die cuts to the top of the velvet panel, with points down. See example picture for placement. Now, adhere the three word pieces in place so that it reads Oh Happy Day. DO NOT add glue onto the folding tabs.
- 2. Next, decide the placement for the moon die cut. Use the sentiment and the other treeline die cut for placement help. Then adhere the moon in place.
- 3. Adhere the other Treeline in place at the bottom of the velvet panel. Some of the treeline will overlap the moon. See example picture.
- 4. Now, use small dots of liquid glue to adhere the Brighter Days sentiment to the velvet panel. See example picture for placement ideas. Add gentle pressure until dry.
- 5. Add the foam panel to the back of the velvet panel. *One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side.
- 6. Finally, trim any excess overhang and then adhere the constructed card front to the front of the card base making sure to leave an even border showing along each edge.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

- 1. Adhere the white panel to the navy splatter panel making sure to leave an even border of navy showing along each edge.
- 2. Adhere the final Treeline die cut to the bottom of the layered panel. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 3. Finally, adhere the decorated panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border.



And you did it!
