Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 Black card base
- 2 Lined panels
- 1 Blue circle
- 1 Green half circle
- 1 Yellow sun set (2 pcs)
- 1 Beaver die cut
- 3 Cattail die cuts
- 3 Cloud die cuts
- 1 heart die cut
- 1 Stitched panel
- 2 Stamped sentiments
- 2 Foam squares
- 1 Coordinating envelope*
- 1 Mailing Liner**



Let's Begin!
We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need one of the striped panels, the blue circle, the green half circle, the sun pieces, the beavers, the cattails, the clouds, the heart, the sentiment you choose and the foam squares.

- 1. To begin, adhere the green half circle to the blue circle, aligning them along the bottom. I recommend not adding glue to the very top edge of the green. This will allow you to tuck elements behind the grass. See example picture.
- 2. Next, adhere the beavers, 2 cattails, the clouds and the heart to the green and blue circle. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 3. Now adhere the striped panel to the front of the black card base making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge. The lines should be depressed inward, not raised. See sample picture.
- 4. Use the foam strips to adhere the decorated circle to the front of the card. *One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side.
- 5. Next, adhere the sun rays die cut to the outer edge of the yellow circle. Then adhere the sun to the card front slightly tucked under the blue circle. See example picture.
- 6. Finally, choose which sentiment fits best and adhere it towards the bottom of the circle.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

- 1. Adhere the remaining striped panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge. The stripes should be depressed into the paper, not raised.
- 2. Add the white stitched panel and decorate it with the remaining cattail. See example picture for placement ideas.
