

# Kit 202

## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



## Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

## Contents:

- 1 Dark brown card base
- 4 Squares (white, sand, cocoa, dark chocolate)
- 2 White panels (1 small, 1 large)
- 6 Beard die cuts (1 white, 2 sand, 2 cocoa, 1 dark chocolate)
- 1 Black sunglasses die cut
- 1 Set of stars
- 1 Foam panel
- 1 Mailing liner  
(mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)\*\*
- 1 Coordinating envelope\*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need everything except the larger white panel.

1. To begin, adhere the 4 squares to the white backer piece. Trim any excess. See example picture for placement ideas.
2. Next, decorate the squares panel with the 6 beard die cuts. Adhere 1 Sand colored beard behind 1 Cocoa beard offsetting it slightly so the sand color shows out from behind. Add this to the white square.
3. Do this again but this time, adhere the sand colored beard over the cocoa beard. Offset it slightly so that the cocoa color shows from behind. Add this to the dark chocolate square.
4. Finally add the white beard to the sand colored square and the dark chocolate beard to the cocoa colored square. See example picture.
5. Finish decorating the dark chocolate square with the sunglasses and stars. TIP: Trim the stars and align them with the edge of the paper to add interest.
6. Lastly, use the foam panel to adhere the decorated squares panel to the card front. \*One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side. I recommend a strong double sided tape or a craft glue.

**That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.**

1. Adhere the larger white panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of brown showing along each edge.
