Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 Navy splattered panel
- 2 Dark blue hexagons
- 1 Light blue hexagon
- 2 Treeline die cuts
- 2 Green grass hillsides
- 1 Moon
- 1 Tent
- 13-Trees die cut
- 1 Canoe
- 1 Van die cut set (backer, the bottom and the top)
- 2 Light blue waterline squares
- 1 Hey There die cut
- 1 Light blue panel
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!
We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need everything except the light blue panel.

- 1. The first thing to do is decorate the hexagon shapes. The two dark blue hexagons will be decorated with scenery pieces. Trim the excess as you go. Adhere the treeline die cut to the hexagon and trim. Next add the light blue waterline piece and trim. Then add the green grass hillside. One will be adhered like it's coming from the left and the other, the right. See example picture for placement ideas. Finish the scenes with the moon and the tent die cuts.
- 2. Next, decorate the light blue hexagon. First construct the van. Adhere the blue piece along the bottom leaving space for the wheels. Then add the white top piece.
- 3. Adhere the 3-Tree die cut to the back of the van making sure to leave room for the addition of the canoe. Adhere the van, tree, canoe combination to the light blue hexagon. Add the Hey There die cut.
- 4. Adhere the navy panel to the front of the card base. Trim any misalignment.
- 5. Next, adhere the decorated hexagons to the card front, with the light blue hexagon overlapping in the center. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 6. Use the foam square to adhere the center hexagon. *One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side.



That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Adhere the remaining blue panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

And you did it!
