Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:


White card base
Stitched diamond panel
Triangles of 6 colors
Dot embellishments
Gray piece
Stamped sentiment
White Wonderful die cut
Black Wonderful die cut
Orange panel (for inside)
Mailing liner
(mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**
Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin! We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need everything except the orange panel.

- 1. To begin, adhere the colored triangle shapes onto the stitched diamond panel. Continue the pattern over the panel leaving an open section towards the bottom. See example picture. Trim any excess.
- 2. Next, adhere the Wonderful die cuts together. Offset the white to let it show from behind.
- 3. Now adhere the gray piece to the open section of the diamond panel. See example picture. Trim any excess.
- 4. Adhere the 'You are' stamped sentiment and the Wonderful die cuts to the gray piece.
- 5. Next, adhere the decorated panel to the front of the card base. It should align edge to edge.
- 6. Finish the card front with the black dot embellishments. One should be placed at the center of each hexagon. They are adhesive backed but you can also add your own adhesive if you'd like.



That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Adhere the orange panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

And you did it!
