

# July '23 Kit B

## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



## Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

## Contents:

- 1 Black card base
- 2 White panels
- 5 Blue candles
- 5 Green candles
- 4 Polka dot candles
- 2 Sets of Happy die cuts
- 1 Black Happy backer
- 1 Black Birthday sentiment
- 5 Flower die cuts
- 14 Candle flames
- Foam strips-adhesive on both sides
- Small foam squares
- 1 Mailing liner\*
- 1 Coordinating envelope\*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need everything except 1 white panel and 1 candle of each color with flames.

1. To begin, adhere the candles to the white panel using foam strips. Offset the heights some for added interest. You can choose to follow my pattern of blue-green-polka dot, or choose your own design. Trim any excess.
2. Next, adhere the flame die cuts to the panel sitting above each candle. Use the small foam squares to adhere them.
3. Now adhere the two sets of HAPPY letters to the black backer. Layering the letters will create added dimension.
4. Adhere the small light pink flowers to the center of the large flowers.
5. Adhere the layered Happy word to the decorated panel leaving the ends free to tuck the flowers in where you choose. After you add the flowers adhere all in place. See example picture for placement ideas.
6. Now, adhere the Black birthday sentiment just below the Happy. See example picture.
7. Finish by adhering the decorated panel to the front of the card base making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge.

**That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.**

1. Decorate the remaining white panel with the three candles.
2. Lastly, adhere the panel to the inside of the card making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge.
