Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

1 White card base

1 White panel

1 Yellow panel

1 Die cut set

1 Striped envelope liner

1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need everything except the yellow panel.

- 1. To begin, construct the sentiment by adhering the white "Popping by to say hi" words onto the black backer. There will be a black border showing along the edges.
- 2. Next, construct the popcorn bucket. Adhere the 3 red stripes to the white bucket piece. The rounded edges are at the top. Align the bottom of each stripe with the bucket. See example picture for correct placement.
- 3. Now add the yellow popcorn backer piece to the back of the bucket. It will only connect a little along that one bottom/top edge. Using some of the small popcorn pieces, decorate the yellow backer. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 4. Adhere the white panel to the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
- 5. Add the layered sentiment towards the bottom and the decorated popcorn bucket above it.
- 6. Finish decorating the card front with the remaining popcorn die cuts. See example picture for placement ideas.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Adhere the yellow panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.



Envelope Liner:

To add the envelope liner, fold forward along the scored line. Then insert it into the envelope and align that fold line with the flap fold of the envelope. Once it's aligned, add adhesive to the back of the top section of the patterned paper. Close the flap to help it adhere correctly to your envelope and your envelope is ready to use!
