Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 White panel
- 1 Light blue panel
- 1 Die cut set
- 1 Floral envelope liner
- 1 Foam panel
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need everything except the light blue panel.

1. To begin, adhere the hugs die cut sentiment onto the white panel towards the bottom. This will help with the spacing of the flowers. See example picture for placement ideas.
2. Next, adhere the small flowers onto the white panel. You can follow my design idea or get creative with your own placement ideas! I began with the bottom row, the darkest pink, and worked up from there. I added the flowers slightly overlapping each other to make a square flower shape.
3. Now add the small gems for decoration. These gems have an adhesive on the back but I chose to adhere them with small dots of glue to make them extra secure.
4. Adhere the decorated panel to the card base using the foam panel (optional). *One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Adhere the light blue panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.



Envelope Liner:

To add the envelope liner, fold forward along the scored line. Then insert it into the envelope and align that fold line with the flap fold of the envelope. Once it's aligned, add adhesive to the back of the top section of the patterned paper. Close the flap to help it adhere correctly to your envelope and your envelope is ready to use!
