## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

White card base
White panel
Orange panel
Stripe set of 4
Hi die cut
Blue patterned envelope liner
Foam squares
Coordinating envelope\*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need everything except the orange panel.

- 1. To begin, adhere the stripes to the white panel. Trim any excess. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 2. Next, adhere the Hi die cut to the decorated panel using the foam squares. The foam has adhesive on both sides.
- 3. Finally, adhere the decorated panel to the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Adhere the orange panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.



## Envelope Liner:

To add the envelope liner, fold forward along the scored line. Then insert it into the envelope and align that fold line with the flap fold of the envelope. Once it's aligned, add adhesive to the back of the top section of the patterned paper. Close the flap to help it adhere correctly to your envelope and your envelope is ready to use!
