# Sept'23 Kit A

### **Let's Make Beautiful Things Together**

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



#### Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

#### Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 Cloud panel
- 1 Blue panel
- 4 Small bushes
- 2 Large bushes
- 3 Houses
- 3 Trees (trunk/top)
- 2 Green hillsides
- 1 Plane
- 2 Stamped sentiments
- Foam squares
- 1 Coordinating envelope\*



Let's Begin! We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need everything except the blue panel, 1 tree set and 1 hillside. These will be used to decorate the inside of your card.

- 1. To begin, adhere 1 green hillside to the bottom edge of the cloud panel. TIP: Leave the top of the hillside unglued so that you can tuck some of the elements behind it. Trim any excess.
- 2. Next, construct all 3 trees by adhering the top to the trunk. You can have the trunk over top or behind, whichever you prefer.
- 3. Now construct your scene with 2 trees, the bushes and the houses. I recommend that you place everything where you like it and then glue it into place. You will add the plane and sentiment later. You can follow my scene placement or create your own! See example picture for placement ideas.
- 4. Adhere the decorated panel to the front of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
- 5. Lastly, use the foam squares to adhere the plane and sentiment. I have included 2 options for you. See example card for placement ideas.

#### That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

- 1. Adhere the remaining hillside and tree to the blue panel for decoration. Trim any excess.
- 2. Lastly, adhere the panel to the inside of the card making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.



And you did it!
