

# Sept'23 Kit B

## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



## Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

## Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 Pink flower panel
- 1 Pink panel
- 1 Gold heart
- 1 Pink heart
- 1 White Hello
- 1 Pink Hello backer
- 1 Gold sequins set
- Foam squares
- 1 Mailing liner\*
- 1 Coordinating envelope\*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need everything except the pink panel.

1. To begin, adhere the white hello to the pink backer. There will be a pink border around the edge. See example picture.
2. Next, adhere the pink heart to the gold heart. Take care with the application of glue. If you add too much you will have glue smooch out onto the gold. I am including a glue swab to help clean up edges as needed.
3. Now, Adhere the pink/gold heart to the floral panel. Allow it to hang over the edge for added interest. Trim any excess and save it for the inside of the card (optional)
4. Next, adhere the floral panel to the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge. This panel has been embossed which can add warping. To help this piece lay flat I recommend laying a book or something similar onto it while it dries.
5. Adhere the layered Hello using the foam squares. \*One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side.
6. Finally, adhere the sequins with small dots of liquid craft glue. See example picture for placement ideas.

**That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.**

1. Decorate the remaining pink panel with the trimmed part of the heart. See example picture.
2. Lastly, adhere the decorated panel to the inside of the card making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.



**And you did it!**
