Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 White embossed panel
- 1 Set of Poinsettias- 8 total, 4 sizes
- 1 Goodie bag (3 red stars and bubbles)
- 4 Leaves (2 dark, 2 light)
- 3 Branches (2 sm, 1 lg)
- 2 White Berry branches
- 1 Merry Christmas
- 1 Red panel
- 1 Coordinating envelope*
- 1 Mailing Liner**



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need everything except the red panel. This will be used to decorate the inside of your card.

1. Let's construct the poinsettias first. There are 4 sizes of poinsettias, extra small, small, medium and large. You will layer them together to create 3 flowers. The largest flower will use the large, medium and small (with glitter). The next flower will layer 2 smalls and an extra small (with glitter). Lastly, you will layer 2 extra smalls (1 with glitter). Each flower's final layer will have a glitter finish.
2. Adhere the white decorative panel to the front of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge. The embossing technique to create the design can warp the paper. Be sure to use enough adhesive for it to lay flat. Spreading glue around with your finger can help this.
3. To create your bouquet, arrange the 3 flowers where you like them on the card front and adhere in place only using adhesive in the center of each flower. Leave the petals loose to allow you to add the greenery.
4. Next, tuck the leaves and branches around the flowers to fill out the bouquet and adhere in place. TIP: leave the ends loose to add dimension. See example picture for placement ideas.
5. Adhere the Merry Christmas to the card front over top of the bouquet.
6. To finish the card front, use small dots of liquid glue to add the red stars and clear bubbles. See example picture for placement ideas.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Adhere the red panel to the inside of the card making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.



And you did it!
