

# Dec '23 Kit A

## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 White panel
- 6 White squares (striped in 2 directions)
- 1 Long stripe set (for inside card)
- 5 Color stripe set
- 1 Set clear embellishment
- 2 Elephants die cuts
- 2 Gifts die cuts
- Foam squares
- 1 Coordinating envelope\*
- 1 Mailing Liner\*\*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the white squares, the shorter stripes set, the clear embellishments, the elephants, 1 gift die cut and the foam squares.

1. To begin, you will add paper stripes to the white squares. Adhere the short strips of colored paper to the 6 white squares. I have added diagonal guide lines to the squares to help you keep them in line. I recommend that you begin with the center yellow stripe. Then add the other stripes alongside the center one. Follow the direction of the guide lines. I chose to only add adhesive to the center of each stripe and keep the ends free. Then I lifted each end to create a more dimensional look. This is optional. See the example picture for reference.
2. Once the square has all 5 stripes, trim the excess overhang to create even edges.
3. Repeat this process until all 6 squares have been decorated and trimmed.
4. Now, arrange the 6 decorated squares to the front of the card base. Line them up along the tops and sides making sure to leave an even border along the edge and in between each one. See the example pictures for placement. Once you have the spacing, adhere them in place.
5. Using the included foam squares, adhere the elephants and gift die cuts to the front of the card. See example picture for placement ideas.
6. Finally, use small dots of liquid glue to adhere the clear embellishment for added decoration. See example picture for placement ideas.

**That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.**

1. For the inside, use the remaining long paper strips to create stripes along the bottom edge of the white panel. Begin with the bottom stripe, aligning to the bottom edge. Trim any excess. Add the rest, aligning each one and trimming.
2. Adhere the decorated white panel to the inside of the card making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
3. Lastly, add the remaining gift die cut for decoration.
