Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 2 Large white panels
- 1 Small white panel
- 1 Paper strip set (3 of each color)
- 1 Large heart, cut out
- 1 Large heart, solid
- 2 Love You So sentiments
- 3 Small heart die cuts
- 1 Heart embellishment
- 2 Foam pieces-adhesive backed
- 1 Set of foam strips-adhesive backed
- 1 Coordinating envelope*
- 1 Mailing Liner**



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need one large white panel, the small white panel, the set of colorful strips, the large heart with the cut out, the 2 Love You So sentiments, the small heart die cuts, the heart embellishment, and the foam adhesive.

1. To begin, you will construct the striped background panel. To do this, you will layer the stripes onto the small white panel. It will be your backer. Begin at the bottom with the Navy color. Take care to line this up straight along the bottom edge of the panel. It will hang over the end and you will trim that later. Once the first stripe is set up correctly, the rest should line up straight, as well. TIP: Using a liquid glue will allow you to adjust the placement
2. Next, adhere the other stripes in the color pattern, adding them one at a time. See example picture. You will end with the lightest blue color and not use the last 4 pink stripes. Those stripes will be used to decorate the inside of the card. Trim any excess. To do this, you can use scissors or a paper trimmer.
3. Adhere one of the large white panels to the card front leaving an even border of white showing along each edge.
4. Now adhere the striped panel onto the card front leaving an even border of white showing along each edge. See example picture.
5. Use the larger foam pieces to adhere the heart to the decorated panel. I recommend using the Love You So die cut to help with placement. This will help you keep the sentiment straight. See example picture for placement ideas. *One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side.
6. Now, adhere the two Love You So die cuts together to add strength and dimension to the sentiment. Then, adhere them to the card using the thin foam strips. These have adhesive on both sides. Just remove the release paper! Trim the foam as needed and add small pieces to the back of the layered Love You So. It should fit in the open space of the heart with a small open border. See example picture.
7. To finish the card, adhere the remaining heart elements. I used some foam to pop up the two smaller hearts. See example picture for placement ideas.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Adhere the remaining pink stripes to the remaining white panel. See example picture. Trim any excess.
2. Add the large heart to the decorated panel allowing it to hang off the edge. Trim any excess. See example picture for placement ideas.
3. Adhere the decorated panel to the inside of the card making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.



And you did it!
