# April '24 Kit B

### Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

#### Contents:

Vanilla card base
Set of color stripes
Set A die cut elements
Set B die cut elements
Sentiment
Sentiment backer
Peach panel (for inside card)
Coordinating envelope\*
Mailing Liner\*\*



Let's Begin! We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the card base, the color stripes, set A and B die cuts, the sentiment and the sentiment backer.

- 1. PLEASE NOTE: Set A includes the die cut elements needed for the left 3 stripes, which include the dark blue, the light blue and the cream. Set B includes the die cut elements for the 3 stripes on the right, the peach, the salmon, and the red. Some of the papers used for the die cuts are two-sided. They have a different color on the back. Try to keep the die cut elements organized by their intended color to help any confusion. TIP: The front of a die cut element will have a slight rounded edge, while the back will be flat.
- 2. Let's start by adding the color stripes to the card base. On the front of the card, adhere the 6 color stripes in order. The stripes will overhang the card base. Trim any excess. See example picture for placement help.
- 3. Using SET A, add the die cut elements to the left 3 stripes. A tweezer or jewel picker tool will help with this step. Set A includes dark blue, light blue (which has red on the back) and cream. Follow my example card for placement ideas, or add the elements in your own design. I layered the two large cream flowers and also two of the smaller blue flowers. You might want to put the sentiment in place (temporarily) for help. NOTE: Reserve the large flower, outline leaf and small flower for the inside of the card. See example picture.
- 4. Next, move on to SET B. Set B includes die cut elements for peach, salmon (which has blue on the back) and red (which has light blue on the back). For these pieces, I layered the peach flowers. I used the smaller flower on top and then added a center circle. I also added leaves to match the colors. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 5. Now, adhere the sentiment backer to the back of the sentiment. They should align edge to edge. Trim any excess.
- 6.Add the sentiment to the front of the card. See example picture for placement ideas.

#### That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

- 1. Adhere the peach panel to the inside of the card making sure to leave an even border of vanilla showing along each edge.
- 2. Add the remaining cream die cut elements to the peach panel for added decoration. See example picture.



And you did it!
