## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!


Where to Start?
First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:
1 White folded card base
1 Rainbow paper
1 Green paper
1 White, starry rectangle
1 Pink, orange and white pattern rectangle
1 Glitter pink square
1 White bow
2 Pink paper lines
1 White bumpy border piece
1 White straight border piece
1 Coordinating envelope*
1 Mailing Liner**


Let's Begin!
We'll construct the card front first.

You will need glue. This can be a glue stick or a bottle of glue. If you use a bottle of glue, I suggest that you squeeze some out onto a scratch paper. Then, use a cotton swab or even a toothpick to put the glue onto your card pieces.
1.Let's start by making the 3 presents. To decorate the white present, put a small amount of glue on the back of the pink lines and then add them to the present. The pink paper lines go across the middle: side to side, and then top to bottom.Use the example picture to help you.
2. Now, decorate the middle present. Put a small amount of glue on the back of the white bumpy border piece and then add it to the present. It should fit right at the top and go from side to side. Use the example picture to help you see where it goes.
3.Decorate the pink glitter present. Put a small amount of glue on the back of the straight, glittery white border piece. It should fit right at the top and hang over the side edges just a bit. Use the example picture to help you.
4. Now that all of the presents are ready, it's time for you to put the card together. Put glue on the back of the rainbow paper and add it to the front of the folded card. Put it right in the middle so that you can see a border of white showing on each side.
5. Next, peel off the sticker paper from the back of the white present and stick it to the bottom of the rainbow paper. Use the example picture to help you see where it goes.
6. Go ahead and do that with the middle present, and the top present too.
7. Once all 3 presents are stuck to the rainbow paper, it is time to add the bow. To do this, put a little bit of glue on the back of the bow, Right In The Middle. You only need glue in the middle because that's the only part that will be touching the top present.
8. Good Job! You made a card!

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Put glue on the back of the green paper and add it to the inside of the folded card. Put it right in the middle so that you can see a border of white showing on each side.

And you did it!
