Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 Sunburst paper
- 1 Purple paper
- 1 Happy Mother's Day
- 1 You're Amazing
- 1 Large white cloud
- 2 Glitter clouds (1 big, 1 small)
- 2 Hippos (1 big, 1 small)
- 2 White hearts (1 big, 1 small)
- 1 Coordinating envelope*
- 1 Mailing Liner**



Let's Begin!

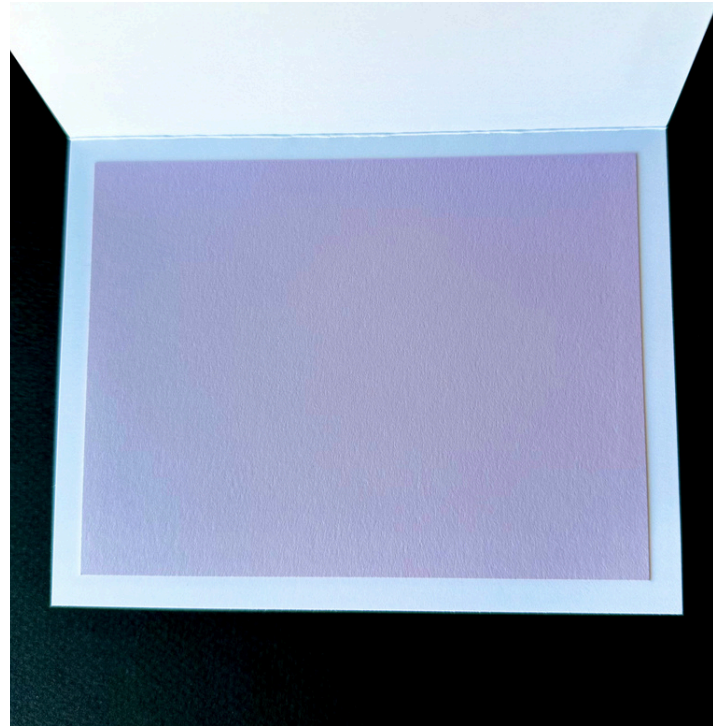
We'll construct the card front first.

You will need glue. This can be a glue stick or a bottle of glue. If you use a bottle of glue, I suggest that you squeeze some out onto a scratch paper. Then, use a cotton swab or even a toothpick to put the glue onto your card pieces.

1. Let's start by adding the sunburst paper to the front of the folded card. Put glue on the back of the sunburst paper and add it to the front of the folded card. Put it right in the middle so that you can see a border of white showing on each side.
2. Next, peel off the sticker paper from back of the big cloud and stick it to the middle of the sunburst paper.
3. Use glue to add the big hippo to the cloud. You only need glue towards the bottom because that's the only part that touches the cloud.
4. Now glue the small hippo to the cloud. Use the example picture to help you see where it goes.
5. Next, use a small amount of glue to add the white hearts to the hippos. The big heart goes on the big hippo. The small heart goes on the small hippo. Use the example picture to help you.
6. The glittery clouds go on each side of the hippos. The straight edge of the cloud lines up along the straight edge of the sunburst paper. Glue the glittery clouds onto your card.
7. Lastly, pick the saying that you want to use. Then glue it to the front of your card.
8. Good Job! You made a card!

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Put glue on the back of the purple paper and add it to the inside of the folded card. Put it right in the middle so that you can see a border of white showing on each side.



And you did it!
