Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 2 Black panels
- 2 White panels
- 1 Hi die cut - solid
- 1 Hi die cut - decorative
- 1 There die cut
- 1 Set of in-lay shapes
- 1 Sequins goodie bag
- Foam squares- adhesive backed
- 1 Coordinating envelope*
- 1 Mailing Liner**



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need everything but 1 black panel and 1 white panel.

1. Let's construct the "Hi" first. Layer the solid Hi behind the decorative one and adhere it into place. I recommend using a light application of a liquid glue to allow time to shift the elements. Align the pieces edge to edge.
2. Now that you have a backer, you will be able to set into place the decorative pieces of the Hi. All of the in-lay pieces are in the goodie bag together but be careful, some of the elements are very small!
3. Follow the pattern in the example picture and use a light application of glue to adhere the floral elements where they fit. TIP Some of the pieces are shaped a little bit differently. Make sure you have figured out where everything goes before you start gluing them down.
4. Layer 1 white panel over a black panel making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge.
5. Next, add that layered panel to the card front leaving an even border of white showing along each edge.
6. Using the pre-cut foam squares, adhere the Hi to the card front. Take care to make sure it is lined up straight. *One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side.
7. Now, use a light application of glue to adhere the There die cut to the card front. See example picture for placement help.
8. Finally, use small dots of glue to add your perfect amount of sequins for decorations.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Adhere the remaining white panel to the remaining black panel making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge.
2. Add the layered panel to the inside of the card.

And you did it!
