Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have! Where to Start?



First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 White scallop edge panel
- 1 Parrot die cut set
- 6 Leaf die cuts
- 1 Hello sentiment
- 1 Enjoy Your Special Day sentiment
- 1 White with green panel
- 1 Foam panel
- 1 Set of clear drop embellishments
- 1 Coordinating envelope*
- 1 Mailing Liner**



Let's Begin!
We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the scallop panel, the parrot die cut set, the Hello sentiment, the foam panel and the clear drop embellishments.

- 1. Let's construct the parrot first. Please take inventory of the parrot pieces. You have the main body in red with a white face section. In that area you will have a white circle eye, a smaller black eye piece and a pink cheek. See example picture for reference. You will also have the black beak. In addition to the main body section you have 3 "wing" pieces in red, yellow and blue. You also have a red tail plus thin tail "feathers" in red, yellow and blue" And lastly you have 2 orange parrot feet. In addition to all of this you have a red square to use as a backer to adhere behind the parrot belly.
- 2. Now that you have your parrot pieces ready, adhere the white face piece using the line provided as a guide. Next, adhere the beak into place. Now, add the white circle eye piece and then the black eye piece on top of it. See example picture for placement ideas. Finally add the pink cheek.
- 3. Construct the wing by layering the yellow wing on top of the blue wing and aligning the sides. Repeat this step with the small red wing. Adhere the wing to the body so that it angles out. See example pictures for placement ideas.
- 4. For the tail, you will adhere the 3 tail feathers onto the tail piece aligning them at the bottom edge. The top edge will be covered by the parrot body. Now adhere it to the body from the back. See example pictures for placement ideas.
- 5. To finish your parrot, add the feet by adhering them from the back of the legs and adhere the red square behind the belly to cover the holes.
- 6. Adhere your finished parrot and the Hello sentiment to the scalloped edged card. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 7. Use the foam panel to adhere the scallop piece to the front of the card base.
- 8. Finally, use small dots of glue to add the clear dot embellishments.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

- 1. Adhere the green leaf die cuts to the bottom section of the remaining white panel. Allow them to overlap and hang over the edges for added interest. Trim any excess.
- 2. Adhere this to the inside of the card making sure to leave and even border along the sides and top but there will be NO border left along the bottom of the card.
- 3. Finally add the remaining sentiment and you're done!
