Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 Pink donut box panel
- 1 Clear acetate panel
- 1 Love You panel
- 1 Sentiment piece
- 1 Donut pieces goodie bag
- 1 Donut sprinkles goodie bag
- Foam strips
- 1 Mini foam square
- 1 Coordinating envelope*
- 1 Mailing Liner**



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You will need all elements except the Love You panel.

1. To begin, use a strong double sided tape or liquid craft glue to adhere the clear acetate panel to the back of the donut box piece. The acetate has a tissue liner that you will not need and can discard.
2. Next, you will build your donuts. REMEMBER to reserve two donuts to decorate the inside of the card. I've included all of the elements to make your donuts match my example card. But you are free to decorate your donuts however you want! The Large heart die cut is to be used to decorate the sentiment on the card front. The Small heart is to be used to decorate the donut on the inside of the card.
3. You will use the donut sprinkles for your decorations And for your shaker bits. See example picture for ideas. To add those tiny sprinkles to the donuts, I recommend using tweezers or a jewel picker tool and a very small amount of liquid glue. TIP: If your glue comes out too fast, add some to scratch paper and apply it with a toothpick.
4. I chose to only allow the sprinkles to be the shaker elements in my card. I found the donut pieces did not shake well and ended up layering over each other. Because of this, I adhered my donuts to the card front as part of the design. However, I encourage you to create your box of donuts in a way that makes you happy!
5. To construct the card front, adhere the donuts to the front of the card base so they show through the box window. Use the box window for placement help.
6. Next, adhere the foam strips onto the back of the pink box panel along all 4 sides. You are creating a wall for the shaker bits to stay contained. It's important for the foam pieces to come together at each intersection. See example picture TIP: the foam can be easily trimmed with scissors to fit as needed. *One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side.
7. To finish the shaker part of the card, add the remaining sprinkles to the center of the card front. Now, adhere the pink box panel to the card front, capturing all of the shaker bits inside. This panel will fit edge to edge on your card front with no border showing. Allow this a moment to dry before you try out the shaker element.
8. Once the glue is dry, confirm that there are no open spaces for the shaker pieces to escape. Patch any holes that you find.
9. To finish the card front, add the Just Wanted You To Know sentiment. Use the mini foam square to adhere the large heart for an extra decoration.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.



1. Adhere the Love You More Than Donuts panel to the inside of the card making sure to leave a narrow border of white showing along each edge.
2. Adhere the two remaining donuts to the panel for added decoration. See example picture for placement ideas.
