Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 Blue card base
- 1 White panel with embossing
- 1 White panel-plain
- 3 Sets of Yarn Balls - Light blue, Dark blue, Coral (6 pc. each)
- 2 Knitting needles
- 1 Accent goodie bag set
- 2 Sentiment squares
- 1 White oval die cut
- 1 Foam panel
- Foam square
- 1 Coordinating envelope*
- 1 Mailing Liner**



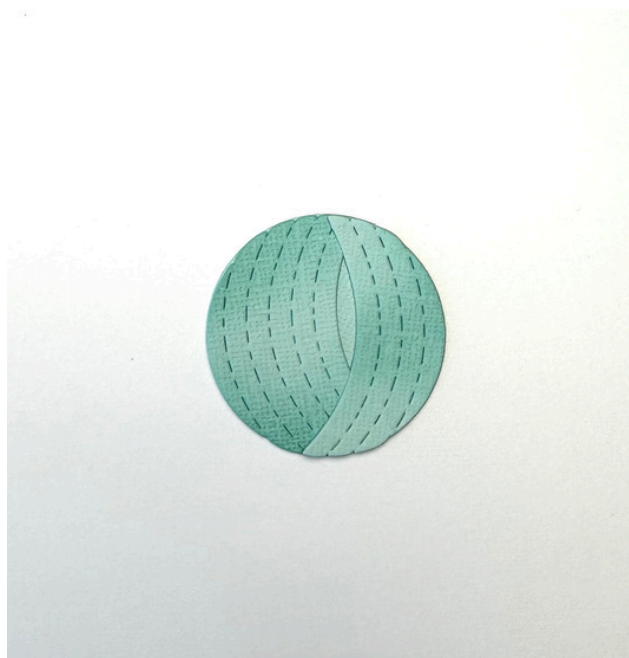
Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need all elements except the plain white panel and the gold and silver scissor pieces.

1. Let's construct the yarn balls first. To do this, you will adhere Four "stitched" parts onto the plain circle. One way to do this is shown in the example pictures. **IMPORTANT:** adhere the final cross piece on the ends only, allowing the center to remain free of adhesive and able to lift up. This is where you will slide the knitting needles through. The single string pieces will be added later.
2. Now, let's add the yarn balls to the embossed white panel. You can choose a layout that you prefer or follow my example picture for placement ideas but make sure you have the yarn tilted to allow the knitting needles a place to "stick out of". Then adhere the single string pieces coming out of each yarn ball.
3. Use the foam panel to adhere the decorated panel to the front of the card base. This will leave an even border of blue showing along each edge. *One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side.
4. Next, tuck each knitting needle into the front cross piece of a yarn ball and adhere in place. See example picture for placement ideas. Tip: I chose to leave the top of the knitting needles free of adhesive for added interest
5. Use the foam square to adhere the sentiment to the card front. NOTE: I have included two sentiments for you to choose from. *One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side.
6. Adhere the three light blue accent stars for added decoration.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.



1. Adhere the remaining white panel to the inside of the card making sure to leave an even border of blue showing along each edge.
2. Adhere the gold scissor grips to the silver pieces and then adhere them together where they cross over each other. Make sure the gold decorative flares face inward and the silver accents are on top. See example picture.
3. Add the scissors to the white panel for decoration.
