## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 Rainbow shaped card base
- 1 Blue rainbow shape panel
- 9 Rainbow stripes
- 2 White rainbow stripe designs
- 2 Clouds
- 1 Sun
- 1 Kind sentiment and backer
- 2 Stamped sentiments
- 1 Set stars
- 1 Set foam strips
- 1 Coordinating envelope\*
- 1 Mailing Liner\*\*



## Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You will need all elements except the blue panel, the stars and the "and I love you" sentiment.

1. Note: The stripe shapes can warp and adjust when you're working with them. This can be helpful or frustrating. I recommend that you handle them with care and use your adhesive to make them obey if needed!
2. It can be tricky to see, but the front of the card base has the stripe lines pressed into it. Try using the light to help see them. Those lines will guide you as you lay down your rainbow stripes. Use the example picture to help you with the color pattern and adhere the largest (darkest red) stripe first. It will leave a white border along the top and bottom edges. Once this stripe is set, the rest of the stripes should begin to inlay where you want them. The pattern will go wide stripe, thin stripe, wide, thin... and so on.
3. Now that the base rainbow is constructed, adhere the 2 white decorative stripes. The larger one goes on the first red stripe. The smaller one goes on the yellow stripe. See the example picture for placement help. These 2 stripes might need coaxing to sit in the proper place, so keep that in mind when you are working with them.
4. Adhere the white "kind" to the blue backer leaving an even border of blue showing along each edge.
5. Use some of the foam strip pieces to adhere the clouds to the bottom of the rainbow. I chose to put the taller cloud on the left side of my rainbow. TIP: Trim the foam pieces to fit your needs. I used 1 1/2 pieces for each cloud.
6. Use the remaining foam strip pieces to adhere the "You Are Too" sentiment, and the "Kind" sentiment to the front of the card base. See example picture for placement ideas.
7. Finally, adhere the sun to the back of the card base so that it shows from behind.

**That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.**



1. Adhere the blue rainbow panel to the inside of the card base.
2. Add the second sentiment if you choose.
3. Adhere the stars for added decoration.
