## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?



First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

## Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 Green panel
- 1 Flower panel
- 1 Girl set (long hair, bangs, face, sweater, skirt)
- 2 Flower pots
- 2 Sentiments
- 1 Goodie bag (2 felt stems, 2 paper stems, 2 flowers, 2 hand cutouts)
- 1 Coordinating envelope\*
- 1 Mailing Liner\*\*



## Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the flower panel, the girl set, 1 flower pot, the felt stems and flower and the "Just a note to say" sentiment.

1. Let's construct the girl first. To do this, adhere the bangs at the top of the long hair piece. The smaller bangs side goes on the left and you will want to leave the bottom bangs edge free of adhesive so that you can tuck the face piece up underneath it.
2. Next, add the face directly under the bangs so that the cut edge is hidden. Take care to keep the face straight. You can do this by watching which way the "neck" is angled.
3. Adhere the sweater onto the neck taking care to keep it straight. Then adhere the green skirt to the back, bottom edge of her sweater. See example pictures for placement ideas.
4. Add her hands by adhering the round side to the back of the sleeve cuff. This will leave the hand-with-thumb shape showing. Both hands are the same. If it seems to not fit, try turning it over.
5. Use small dots of glue on the back of the hands to adhere the flower pot in place. It should sit aligned with the hands and just below the skirt. See example picture for help. Leave the rest of the pot free of adhesive.
6. Add the flower panel to the front of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
7. Adhere the girl to the card front with the pot sitting along the bottom edge.
8. Now, use a liquid glue to add the felt stems. Tuck the bottoms of the stems behind the flower pot. Glue the white felt flower to the top part of the long stem. Trim excess if needed. See example picture for placement ideas. You can secure the flower pot in place now.
9. Finally, add the "just a note to say" sentiment to the front of the card.

**That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.**

1. Adhere the green panel to the inside of the card making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge. Make sure the smooth side is facing up to make writing a message a little easier.
2. Decorate the inside of the card with the remaining plant pieces and sentiment that says "I've been thinking of you".
