Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 Green panel
- 1 Flower panel
- 1 Hello die cut with backer
- 1 Outline flower set (2 large, 2 medium, 2 small)
- 1 Outline leaf set (large, medium, small)
- 1 White leaf backer set
- 1 White flower backer set
- 5 White medium flowers
- 1 Stamped sentiment
- 1 Goodie bag (variety foam squares, enamel dots)
- 1 Coordinating envelope*
- 1 Mailing Liner**



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You will need all elements except the green panel, a small outline flower and its backer, and 5 medium white flowers.

1. To begin, adhere each of the outline flowers to a coordinating white backer. They will not align perfectly. Add adhesive only in the center. Use your fingers to gently bend the outline petals away from the backer petals for extra dimension.
2. Now, add a coordinating enamel dot to the center of each flower. The 2 darkest flowers will use 2 the dark dots. These are adhesive backed but you can add your own adhesive if you feel it's needed. TIP: Using the sharp tip of a scissors or piercing tool can help when working with such tiny, sticky embellishments.
3. Next, adhere the outline leaves to the white leaf backers. They won't align perfectly. I only added adhesive toward one end and let the rest lay free.
4. Adhere the Hello die cut to the white Hello backer making sure to leave an even border of white along each edge.
5. Now, add the flower panel to the front of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
6. Arrange the flowers and leaves on the front of the card until you like the placement. I have included an example picture of my flower placement to help. REMEMBER: reserve the darker small flower for the inside of the card.
7. Adhere the flowers and leaves in place. Use your layered Hello to help with placement if needed. I used small foam squares to pop up 2 of my flowers, so I included those in your kit (plus 1 more) if you want to do that too. I used a foam square on the small flower in the lightest green, and also on the dark green medium flower (bottom right corner).
8. Now, using foam squares adhere the layered Hello and, Love and Hugs sentiment, to the card.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.



1. With the smooth side up on the green panel, use the 5 white flowers to make an offset border along the bottom edge. Trim any excess. See example picture.
2. Next, use the final layered outline flower to overlay one of the border flowers. Trim any excess.
3. Adhere the green panel to the inside of the card making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
