Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 White arch frame panel, arch die cut and arch outline
- 1 Blue panel, patterned
- 1 Blue panel, plain
- 2 Sentiments
- 1 Set of girl die cuts (dress, hair, face, arm, hand)
- 2 Cats (1 white, 1 black)
- 1 Plant set goodie bag (4 planter pots w/rim pieces, 4 plants, 7 pink flowers, 4 white flower centers)
- 1 Coordinating envelope*
- 1 Mailing Liner**



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You will need everything except the plain blue panel and one reserved plant and planter. See example picture for details.

1. To begin, you will construct the plants first. Adhere the rim pieces to the planters with a light application of liquid glue. Next, adhere the plants to the back of the planters. TIP: The largest plant will share space with the cat. I recommend you offset it so that they both fit in the planter. See example picture for help. DO NOT add the flowers at this time.
2. Next, add the cat to the large planter. I have included 2 cats so that you can choose which one you'd prefer. You can use them both on your card, or just one, like in my example.
3. Now, adhere the hair to the face piece, only adding adhesive to the area at her head. This will allow you to tuck her dress under her hair when it's time. If you want your girl to be looking downward at the cat, you might need to adjust the angle. Trim any areas of the face die cut that stick out. See example picture.
4. At this point, use the patterned blue panel to help with placement. You are almost ready to assemble. Choose the placement of the Girl and the Cat Plant. Use the arm piece to help you decide which angle is right. Adhere the dress to the neck portion so that it sits under the hair.
5. Now, decide where the arm and hand will sit and adhere the hand to the back of the arm, at the angle you choose. Trim any overhang if necessary. (I had to trim a little on mine) See example picture for placement ideas.
6. Finally, adhere the girl and Cat Plant in place toward the bottom edge of the patterned blue panel and then adhere that panel to the front of the card base.
7. Next, adhere the arch frame panel to the front of the card. It will fit edge to edge.
8. Now, use a light application of glue and add the arch outline to sit just inside of the frame. See example picture.
9. Add two of the remaining plants to the card front and decorate the plants with the pink flowers (there will be variation in flower shape) Some flowers will need white centers added. See the example for placement ideas.
10. Lastly, add the sentiments to the card front. The sentiments have fold lines, allowing them to pop up off the page, if you'd like. To do that, fold back at the line closest to the words, and then fold up and the line farthest from the words.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Adhere the light blue panel to the inside of the card making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
2. Add the white arch die cut to the blue panel and decorate it with the remaining plant. See example picture for placement ideas.
