Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 Green panel
- 5 Colored stripes
- 1 Basket stripe
- 1 Grass stripe
- 1 I'd Pick You set
- 1 Circular sentiment
- 1 Veggie set goodie bag (tomatoes, carrot, peppers, peas, onion, beet)
- Foam strip
- 1 Coordinating envelope*
- 1 Mailing Liner**



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You will need everything except the green panel and the circular sentiment.

1. Build the colorful stripes by adding the vegetables and trimming the excess. The tomatoes, the carrot and the peppers all have stems that will need to be added first. See example picture for placement help. NOTE: the light green and yellow pepper have stems the same size. The dark green pepper uses the larger stem. This differs from the example picture.
2. Next, adhere the grass stripe to the top of the basket stripe so that it sticks out the top. See example picture.
3. Now it's time to create the card front. Using the foam strip, adhere the basket stripe to the bottom of the card front, making sure to line up with the rounded corners. *One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side.
4. Next, add the decorated color stripes to the top section of the card front and trim any excess. I recommend laying out the stripes to see how they will fit before you adhere them in place. See example picture for placement help. TIP: I placed my stripes close together so it didn't interfere with the rounded edge at the top.
5. Add the small tomatoes and beet for decoration. See example picture.
6. Finally, adhere the black "I'd pick you" words the the white backer pieces and add them to the basket stripe.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Adhere the green panel to the inside of the card making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
2. Add the circular sentiment to the inside of the card.
