## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 2 White panels
- 4 White stripes
- 3 White squares
- 1 Flower set ( Flowers with centers)
- 4 Green stems
- 2 Sentiments
- 1 Gem goodie bag
- Foam squares
- 1 Coordinating envelope\*



## Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You will need everything except one of the white panels, one small flower and the medium sized stem.

1. Begin by building the background panel. To do this, adhere the white stripes to one of the white panels. Begin with a stripe across the top of the panel. Next, leave an open space between the stripes and adhere the second one aligned horizontally to the first. Repeat this step for the last two stripes. Trim any excess. See example picture.
2. Next, adhere the striped panel to the front of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
3. Now, use the foam squares to adhere the white squares to the front of the card. They should sit close together with a wide border that allows enough space for the sentiment. See example picture for placement ideas. \*One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side.
4. Decorate the card front with the three green stems and flowers. Adhere the two large stems in place first. The widest piece goes on the left with the accent flower towards the bottom. The other stem fits towards the right. I connected mine by tucking one leaf under another. Leave some areas free of adhesive to add interest. I added the smallest stem below the large flower after the flower was in place.
5. Before adding the flowers to the card front, use a pencil or something similar to help you curl your petals. This adds a fun dimension but is optional. Adhere the coordinating centers to the flowers and then add them to the card. Remember, one flower will be reserved for the inside of the card. Don't forget the accent flower tip.
6. Next, add the sentiment that fits best for you and finish off with the gem embellishments. I recommend using a light application of glue for the gems. Add a dot of glue and then set the gem onto the dot. Allow it to dry set.

**That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.**



1. Adhere the remaining white panel to the inside of the card making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
2. Add the remaining stem and flower to the inside of the card for decoration. See example picture for placement ideas.
