Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 Blue card base
- 2 White with blue panels
- 8 Flowers and centers
- 9 Leaves
- 1 Friend die cut w/backer
- 1 Gem set
- Foam squares
- 1 Coordinating envelope*
- 1 Mailing Liner**



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You will need everything except one of the panels, one leaf and one flower with its center.

1. Begin by adding the centers to each of the flowers.
2. Now it's time to create the flower panel.
3. Adhere the flowers to one of the white w/blue panels using the foam squares. Spread them out to create a random spacing. See example picture for placement ideas. Keep in mind- you will need the center of the flower to keep the foam dimension in place.
4. Add one leaf to each flower, to fill in the open spaces. The center flower will get two leaves.
5. Trim the excess from the panel and adhere it to the front of the card base.
6. To add the Friend sentiment, first adhere the word Friend to the white backer. Don't forget the dot to the "i", it can be found in the gem goodie bag. Use the foam strip to add the Friend sentiment to the front of the card (optional). See example picture.
7. Finally, use small dots of liquid glue to add the gems for decoration.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Adhere the remaining flower and leaf to the white w/blue panel and trim any excess.
2. Add the panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of blue showing along each edge.

You did it!
