Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base (largest panel is the front)
- 1 Pink floral fitted sheet
- 2 Pink flat sheet set
- 1 White scallop piece
- 2 White pillows
- 2 Blue pillows
- 1 Blue floral blanket
- 1 White quilted bedspread
- 1 Sentiment
- 1 Coordinating envelope*
- 1 Mailing Liner**



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the front and the inside of the card together.

1. For this card, everything is a part of the bedding. I hope the 'terms' make sense!
2. Begin by adding the sentiment to the bottom of the floral fitted sheet.
3. Now, adhere that to the inside of the card base. It will align to the bottom edge of the FRONT of the card base and sit centered. See example picture of the inside of the card.
4. Next, adhere the blue floral blanket to the front of the card aligning it to the bottom edge.
5. Create the white quilted bedspread by adhering the three layers together aligning them at the top and sides. NOTE: The patterns on the bedspread paper have a wide variation, but they are all fabulous!
6. Next, adhere the quilted bedspread to the blue blanket aligning it at the bottom.
7. The folded over "flat sheet" is the plain pink paper. Adhere the two pieces together so that the triangle piece attaches over the very end of the rectangle. See example picture for how they align.
8. Attach the white scallop piece just behind the rectangle piece so that it sticks out the bottom and trim any excess.
9. Once this has all been constructed you can attach it to the top of the blue floral blanket to cover the cut edge. It will hang over the left and right edge a little bit. See example picture for placement help.
10. Next, adhere the two white pillows to the card. One will go on the front of the card and attach to the pink flat sheet. This way it is part of the card front when you open it. The other pillow is adhered to the floral fitted sheet on the inside to look like it's behind the blanket. TIP: I curved the pillow corners over a pencil to add dimension to the die cut before adhering them.
11. Finally, add the two blue pillows over the white ones. These pillows are a double sided paper. Choose which pattern you prefer.
