Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive 😊 But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 White lined panel
- 1 White frame
- 1 Acetate panel (tissue paper backing)
- 1 Flower set (2 Flowers with centers)
- 1 Leaf set (leaf stem, leaf)
- 1 Sentiment
- 1 Red panel
- 1 Shaker bits goodie bag
- Foam strips
- 1 Mailing liner (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need everything except the red panel.

1. You will start by building the shaker "box". To do this, add a very light application of glue to the back of the lines on the lined panel, including all outer edges. Then adhere it to the acetate panel (without the tissue). Using too much glue will cause the glue to squish out onto the acetate, so take care.
2. Next, add the four foam strips to the four sides of the acetate panel. You are creating a wall for the shaker bits to stay contained. It's important for the foam pieces to come together at each intersection. TIP: the foam can be easily trimmed with scissors to fit as needed. See example picture. The foam will show through the front of the lined panel but don't worry about that too much. You will be adding a frame piece over the top to hide them.
3. To finish the shaker part of the card, add the shaker bits inside the foam walls. Remove the release paper from the foam strips to expose the adhesive. Adhere the card base to the foam strip walls to enclose the shaker bits inside. TIP: You can add glue along the foam strips to give some adjustment time. Confirm that all sides are adhered completely before trying out the shaker.
4. To decorate the front of the card, adhere the white frame to the front of the shaker. It will sit just inside the outside edge.
5. Next, add the leaves and flowers to the card front. First, adhere the large stem to the bottom corner. The large flower lays over top of it, and then the small flower lays on that. Tuck the single leaf under the small flower and add the flower centers.
6. Add the sentiment, and you're finished.



Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

1. Adhere the red panel to the inside of the card making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

And you did it!
