Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

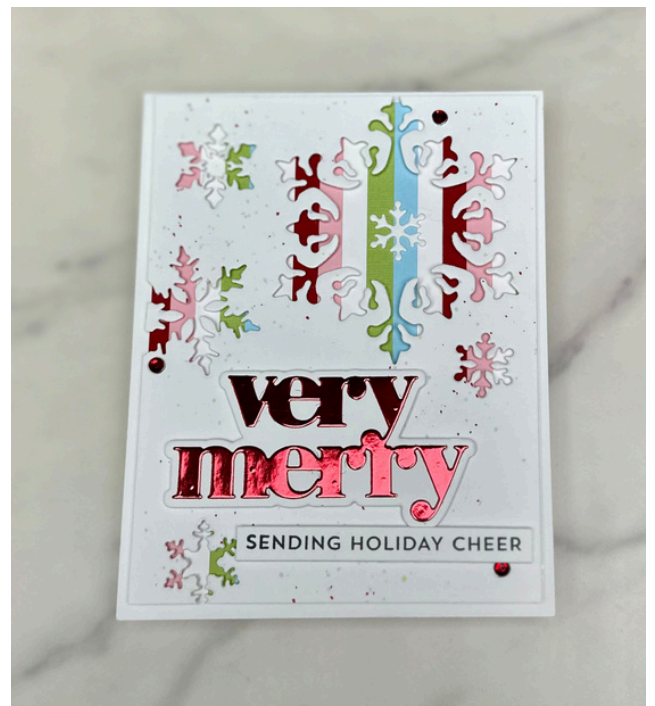
Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 Green panel
- 1 White panel
- 1 Snowflake die cut panel
- 1 Set paper stripes
- 1 Very Merry sentiment
- 1 Stamped sentiment
- 1 Goodie bag (snow flakes, gems)
- Foam squares set
- Mailing Liner
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You will need everything except everything except the green panels and 3 snowflakes.

1. Begin by creating the striped background panel. To do this adhere the paper stripes to the white backer piece provided. (not the card base) I've included a picture of the pattern I used. You can use my pattern or create your own! Add a thin line of liquid glue to the white backer and line up the first stripe so that it is straight against the far left edge. With the first stripe straight, the rest of the stripes should line up correctly. Trim the excess when you're done.
2. I have provided 2 large pieces of adhesive backed foam. These are for you to use as needed on this card. They are meant to be trimmed as you need. The next step is to add foam adhesive to the back of the snowflake panel. This will pop it up off of the stripes and create a neat shadow effect. Trim the foam into the shapes you need to support the panel. I recommend that you also include all four corners. *One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side.
3. The provided foam adhesive will also need to be trimmed to be used behind the Very Merry sentiment and the stamped sentiment when it's time.
4. With the foam adhesive in place on the back of the snowflake panel, adhere the snowflake panel to the striped panel. It should align edge to edge. Trim any excess if necessary. See example picture.
5. Adhere the layered snowflake/striped panel to the front of the cardbase making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
6. Add a snowflake to the center of the large snowflake opening. I chose the smallest snowflake.
7. Next, adhere the Very Merry to its white backer. There will be a white border all around. Then adhere it to the front of the card using a piece of foam adhesive.
8. Now, use a piece of foam adhesive to add the stamped Sending Holiday Cheer to the front of the card.
9. Finally, use small dots of liquid glue to add the gems for decoration. See example picture for placement ideas.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.



1. Adhere the remaining snowflakes to the green panel and trim any excess.
2. Add the panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
