## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.



## Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 Yellow panel, stamped
- 1 Yellow panel, plain
- 1 Die cuts goodie bag
- Foam squares set
- 1 Coordinating envelope\*
- 1 Mailing Liner\*\*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You will need everything except one anchor, one heart and the plain yellow panel.

1. All of the die cut pieces are in the goodie bag. This includes 3 pieces for the sailboat, 1 sun, 2 anchors with coordinating white hearts (one set is for the inside of the card), a white ring with 4 blue accents and 1 starfish.
2. Before adding them to the card front you will need to put them together.
3. To begin, construct the sailboat. To do this, adhere the dark blue bottom piece over the white bottom of the boat. Next, adhere the light blue sail over the white sail. This gives you a 3 color sailboat. See example picture for help.
4. Construct the white ring by adhering the 4 blue accents. The wider side of each accent goes to the outside of the ring. See example picture for help.
5. Now glue the heart to the anchor. See example picture for placement ideas.
6. Once the elements have been constructed, you are ready to add them to your yellow panel with the stamped sentiment saying Sending You Sunshine.
7. I have included some foam adhesive for you to use. I have trimmed them to a very narrow width to help them hide behind the small elements. If dealing with such small foam strips is too aggravating, I encourage you to adhere the pieces flat to the yellow panel. If you want to add the elements popped up with the foam strips, like my example, use scissors to trim the foam adhesive to meet the size needed.
8. To put the front panel together: Lay out the elements, using a ruler if necessary, lining them up evenly spaced. See example picture. Remove the release paper from the foam adhesive and adhere them in place. NOTE: I adhered the sun flat but the sailboat raised
9. Finally, adhere the decorated panel to the front of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

**That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.**

1. Adhere the remaining anchor and heart to the plain yellow panel.
2. Now, add that panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
